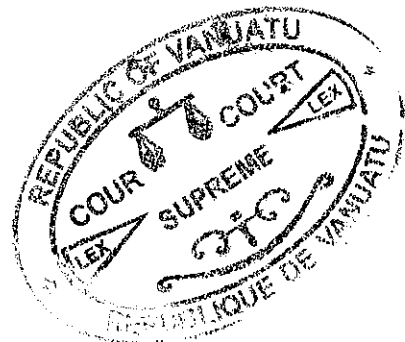

ORDERS

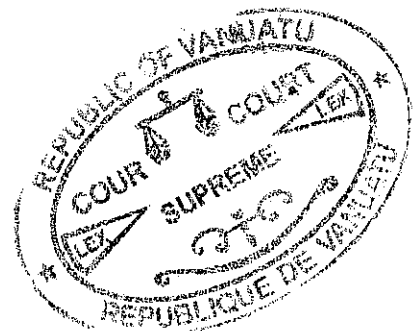
Having inquired into the Application pursuant to Rules 2.7 and 2.8 of the Constitutional Procedure Rules,
